

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

- Citizen science: "assists the needs and concerns of citizens" A. Irwin / "Citizens can produce reliable scientific knowledge"







Social tipping points



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Social tipping points, at which a small change can trigger rapid and large changes.


Self-reinforcing positivefeedback mechanisms, that inevitably lead to a qualitatively diferent state.



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




CoAct: Codesigning citizen social science for collective action (2020-2022)

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 CSS understood as... participatory research co-designed and directly driven by citizen groups sharing a social concern.





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
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
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xAire: NO2 concentration levels (2018)



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UrGentEstimar: Social cohesion



Behavioural domains by gender pairing. Cooperation refers to the ratio of cooperative decisions; Expectation refers to the ratio of positive expectations regarding the partner's behaviour, namely cooperation; Amusement refers to the ratio of positive arousal following eye contact; Accuracy refers to the ratio of correct guesses regarding the partner's behaviour; *Payoff* refers to the average payoff. The number in each cell shows the normalised value; the colour represents the standardised mean difference, calculated as the difference in means between groups for each behavioural domain divided by the standard deviation of each behavioural domain.

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In a word: the best is experience. I will not say that the experience is not obtained in the constant treatment with a **library**, but above the library the experience prevails.




